Week 1 - Discussion Guide

There are times in our life where we, like the disciples on that Emmaus road need to be led. But after some time, as we grow to be more like Jesus, we also need to be people who are leading others. We might not always have the answer and we might not always feel ready, but this is what it looks like to bring people to Christ. We don't need to yell at people on a street corner, we don't need to be able to debate the fine minutiae, we don't need to be perfect. We just need to be able to come alongside someone and ask "What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?"

Being Led

1. Can you think of a time where you had a meaningful conversation with someone about "what matters most"? What did it feel like? How valuable was it for you?
2. How have you been led by others in the past?
 - a. Who are the "Gary's" in your life? Do you have one now?
 - b. What did they do to come alongside you?
 - c. What impact on your life did they have?
3. How do you personally still need to be led as a Christ follower?

Open Eyes

Read Luke 24:13-35

1. These 2 disciples had their hopes crushed. Thinking about your friends, neighbors, coworkers, etc., do you think that resonates with them? With you?
2. What did Jesus do that stands out for the two disciples?

You Are Ready

Read Matthew 4:18-22, Matthew 10:1-15

Early in Jesus' career, He gathered the disciples and sent them off to share the good news. They weren't asked to figure everything out first, they were asked to follow and then Jesus sent them out.

1. Do you feel ready to lead people in following Christ? If not, why not?
 2. What can we do in this group to help us to talk about faith more?
 3. What are some of the tools we need to get better at sharing our faith?
