This week in Act 4 of The Story, we focused on Jesus: the climax of redemption. Through his life, death, and resurrection, he not only reveals God (because he's God in person), but he puts God's Kingdom on display for all to see - bringing it to earth as it is in heaven in a way that forever changed the world. He calls each of us to repent and believe (Mark 1:15). Revealing God and dealing with sin once and for all, he fulfills the promise and vocation given to Israel, proving God's faithfulness.

KNOW

- Knowing Jesus: for each of the below questions, try to connect your answer to a story from scripture.
- What is most attractive/impressive to you about Jesus?
- What quality do you most admire in Jesus that you wish you had more of?
- What puzzles you most about Jesus?
- How has Jesus changed your view of who God is?
- What is most significant about Jesus' death in your view?

LIVE

- Read Mark 1:15. Now that the Kingdom has come, we're called to repent (turn) and believe (follow him).
 - What has 'repentance' looked like for you (coming home, changed mind/behavior, etc.)? Share an example.
 - Share a story (or *the story*) of how you have responded to this call from Jesus.
 - How can we help you repent and believe? Seriously: what can we do to help you respond to this call?
- What are some 'signs' of resurrection/new creation that you have seen in your life, or others' lives?

TELL

- If you had to give an elevator pitch for the significance of Jesus, what would you say? What is essential to the pitch? What could be left out? How would you organize your pitch? Practice telling it!
