Memory Verse:

“Don't do anything only to get ahead. Don't do it because you are proud. Instead, be humble. Value others more than yourselves.” Philippians 2:3 NIV

PRAYER: God, thank you for your son, Jesus. Thank you for His life, for His teaching, and for the example He gave of how we should treat others. In the heat of the moment, when things are at their craziest for us, please help us hear the nudge of Your Holy Spirit. Help us to think like Jesus and act like Him. Help us to take His example and live it out in our lives. Please help us slow down long enough to remember what Jesus did and put others first like He did. We love you. Amen

Activity: Serve it up!

What you'll need: Various (depending on project chosen)

WHAT YOU DO: Choose a service project you can have your child do or help with from home. Examples: Making cards, washing the car, cleaning their room, helping make dinner, etc.

WHAT TO SAY AFTER: “That was a big job! And it might not have been your favorite way to spend time but how did you feel while we were working? How do you feel now that we are finished?”

We **put others first because Jesus put us first**. How else can we put others first this week?

Activity: Clump Sculptures

What you'll need: Just your family :)

WHAT YOU DO: Call out shapes and work together to clump together to make that shape. Use the conversation starters below each shape to talk about how we can show humility by putting others first.

- Form the shape of the numeral one
 - Finish the sentence: I can let others go first when....
- Form the shape of a slice of pizza
 - When there's one piece left, what can you do?
- Form the shape of a baseball and a bat
 - How would a good teammate put others first?
- Form the shape of a heart
 - How does putting others first demonstrate God's love to them?
