### Activity: Cross the road!

What you'll need: Shoeboxes or bins

**WHAT YOU DO:** Work together as a family (or form teams). Have a finish line about 20ft away and pretend the space between the bin and the finish line is a gooey muddy road. Use the bins to work together to get across

**WHAT TO SAY AFTER:** "In today's story, some friends were walking together down a road. It was most likely a dusty road rather than muddy one, but they saw something along the way that changed their lives forever.

**PRAYER:** God, your plan is so big! Thank you for always hearing our prayers. Thank you for being right by our side - even when things happen that we don't totally understand. I pray that all of us - myself included - will never stop wanted to learn more about you. Please help us to be wise enough to listen and brave enough to admit that we don't know everything. We love you! Amen

### Activity: Cup up, cup down

What you'll need: Bible, plastic cups

**WHAT YOU DO:** Form two teams (up team and down team), give each person 3 cups and have them place them around the room. Explain that while you read the Bible story Luke 24:13-35 you will pause and they will have 10 seconds to flip over as many cups as they can to match their teams direction. The goal is for your team to have the most cups in the correct direction.

**WHAT YOU SAY AFTER:** "It's a good thing our story ended when it did otherwise our game could have gone on forever! Just when you think you've turned over every cup, you discover there are more. It's never ending. That's also true when it comes to learning important things. **There is always more to discover about God's plan.** We're always learning and finding new ways to live for him. Just like Jesus helped the men in the story better understand God's plan, He's doing that for us too. As followers fo Jesus, we never quit discovering more about God and the plans He has for our lives. So keep listening, reading, praying, and talking to those who love God."

**Discussion Questions** Talk through the following:

- What is it so hard for us to admit when we don't know something?
- If there is always more to discover about God, how do we do that? **Memory Verse:**
