Activity: Jesus is Lord

What you'll need: Translation App

WHAT YOU DO: Look up how to say, "Jesus is Lord," in various languages. Then pick a language and come up with a handshake or clap to go along with the sentence. Practice saying the phrase while you complete your action. In today's story we found out more about how Jesus is Lord!

Memory Verse: Let us not become tired of doing good. At the right time we will gather a crop if we don't give up. Galatians 6:9

PRAYER: God, it's so amazing to see how You gave the gift of the Holy Spirit to the disciples just like Jesus promised. When we believe, You give US the Holy Spirit too. We know that with the help of the Holy Spirit we can be determined to follow You and finish what we've started. Activity: Remember your verse

What you'll need: Cheerios or From Loops, pipe cleaners

WHAT YOU DO: Divide into two teams, give each team one pipe cleaner and one piece of cereal for every word in the memory verse. Using only one hand and the pipe cleaner loop one piece of cereal on for each word in the memory verse. Once completely tie the pipe cleaner around their wrist to wear the rest of the day and use it to practice the memory verse.

WHAT YOU SAY AFTER: "I didn't know if we were going to get that done. That took some serious determination for you all, and you didn't give up. My prayer is that this bracelet will remind you of your memory verse but also that no matter what you face **God gives you what you need to keep going.**"

Discussion Questions Talk through the following:


- Can you think of a time you wanted to give up but you didn't? What helped you to keep going?
- READ: John 14:26 *But the Father will send the Friend in my name to help you. The Friend is the Holy Spirit. He will teach you all things. He will remind you of everything that I have said to you.*
- How does it feel to know that God is with you in a specific and intentional way?
- What can you do to remember this verse and let it encourage you when you get worn out?
- What current situation are you in right now that you need access some determination for?

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RECIPE

WHAT YOU NEED: Plastic tablecloth, a large clear bowl, a wooden spoon, foam shaving cream, a three oz. box of lemon gelatin (not sugar free), white school glue, baking soda, saline solution, plastic cups, and wet wipes for messy fingers (Optional: yellow food coloring)

WHAT YOU DO BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Cover the table with a tablecloth. Gather the ingredients for making the slime using the quantities below. 4 cups foam shaving cream 1 tablespoon lemon gelatin dissolved in 1 tablespoon warm water ½ cup white school glue ½ teaspoon baking soda 2 tablespoons saline solution

WHAT YOU DO DURING THE ACTIVITY: Gather around the table. Make the slime following the steps below. Make sure that you name each ingredient and describe each step as you go.

1. Add the four cups of shaving cream to the bowl.
2. Add lemon gelatin and water mixture, yellow food coloring (if desired), and stir into shaving cream to incorporate.
3. Add ½ cup white school glue. Gently stir to combine.
4. Add ½ teaspoon baking soda to the mixture, and stir gently.
5. Add two tablespoons of saline solution and whip mixture to activate the slime. Slime should start to pull away from the sides of the bowl.
6. Squeeze a drop or two of saline solution on your hands, pull the slime out of the bowl, and knead until it’s smooth and can be stretched.
7. Give everyone a lump of slime and a plastic cup. Encourage them to knead their slime and let it ooze from their hands into and out of the cups as they “pour” their lemonade.
