### Activity: So Puzzled

What you'll need: Puzzles

WHAT YOU DO: Set out puzzles that are missing pieces. Work together to put together the puzzles. At the end provide the piece.

WHAT YOU SAY AFTER: Did anyone else feel like that was nearly impossible without the missing pieces? What were you thinking when you realized something wasn't quite right? Sometimes life looks a bit questionable, just like these puzzles did without the right pieces. In today's Bible Story we heard about a man who had questions and got answers to complete his pictures!

**PRAYER:** God, you are so big! There is so much about you that we can discover when we read the Bible and when we talk about you with other people. Thank you for inviting us to ask questions. Please give us that strength to keep going even when we're confused or don't understand. Help us to have faith like Philip and the official did - even in those times when we can't see the whole picture. We love you. Amen

### Activity: Hop to it!

What you'll need: Chalk, rocks

WHAT YOU DO: Draw a hopscotch board and place question marks in two of the squares. Each turn throw a rock and if it lands on a question mark answer one of the questions below while you do hopscotch. If it doesn't land on a question mark you can just play.

### QUESTIONS:

- Who appeared to Philip in the middle of him telling people about Jesus?
- What did the angel tell him to do?
- Who did Philip encounter while traveling on the desert road?
- What was the man doing?
- What did God tell Philip to do?
- And what did Philip do after he realized the Ethiopian official needed help understanding the Scripture?
- What big decision did the Ethiopian official make after learning all about Jesus?

### Discussion Questions Talk through the following:

- Why is it important to ask questions?
- What happens if we don't understand and we don't ask questions?
- When is it hard to ask questions?
- Are there questions that have no answers?
