

Activity: Fan Verse

What you'll need: Chalk, rocks

WHAT YOU DO: Write or have kids write out this month's memory verse on a piece of paper (decorate if desired). Fold the paper into a fan like shape and use the idea of 'wind' to discuss our monthly verse.

WHAT YOU SAY: "According to our memory verse, faith is trusting that something will happen even though we can't see it happening yet. Just because we can't see something doesn't mean it isn't real. We can't see the wind, or touch the wind, or taste the wind. We can only hear it and feel it. Yet, no one doubts that wind exists. In many ways, faith is like the wind, we can't see faith or touch it or taste it. We can only hear it and sometimes we feel it - all through the stories of those who came before us. When you know how Jesus has affected others' lives, you can see how he can work in your life, too! **You can know Jesus even though you've never seen him.**

Memory Verse:

Faith is being sure of what we hope for.

It is being sure of what we do not see.

Hebrews 11:1

Discussion Questions Talk through the following:

- If we can't see Jesus, how do we know He's real?
- What do we see around us that helps us know God is real?
- When you have doubts about your faith, who can you talk to?

GROUP GAME

Picture it!

Create two teams and each team down in a line, with each player facing the next players back. Give every person a chopstick or unsharpened pencil. The person at the back of the line 'draws' something on the back of the person in front of them and they they move it forward (like telephone) to the front of the line. The person at the front of the line guesses what was being drawn. Rotate and play a few rounds.

WHAT YOU SAY AFTER: You had to trust a lot in what you couldn't see. In the Bible Story this week we heard about something we couldn't see but something we can definitely trust!
